1- A **still life** is a work of art depicting mostly inanimate subject matter.

2- **Sculpture** is the branch of the visual arts that operates in three dimensions.

3- A basic distinction is between sculpture in the round, free-standing sculpture, such as statues, not attached (except possibly at the base) to any other surface, and the various types of relief, which are at least partly attached to a background surface.

4- sound sculpture, light sculpture, environmental art, environmental sculpture, street art sculpture, kinetic sculpture (involving aspects of physical motion), land art, and site-specific art
