1- A **Geometric perspective** is an approximate representation, on a flat surface (such as paper), of an image as it is seen by the eye.

2- A **metal** is a material (an element, compound, or alloy) that is typically hard, opaque, shiny, and has good electrical and thermal conductivity.

3- An alloy is a mixture of two or more elements in which the main component is a metal.

4- The aim of making alloys is generally to make them less brittle, harder, resistant to corrosion, or have a more desirable color and luster.
